Meeting Minutes - April 28, 2016

PUBLIC COMMENT

WELCOME TO NEW MEMBERS

Introductions were provided to new members, Stacey Klemp and Mike Schrad.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion by Dick Miller to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2016, regular meeting was unanimously approved.

KEY BANK DISCLOSURE

New member Stacey Klemp is employed by Key Bank. An affidavit was presented explaining her relationship with Key Bank and disclosing her interest publicly. Her relationship with Key Bank does not prevent her from serving on PRAC.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE STATUS

The Task Force met last week, and all of the small groups have submitted their reports. The consultant has compiled the information. Open Space and Recreation Services staff will meet to review the information next week.

NEW BUSINESS

Elections. Dick Miller nominated Doug Errett to serve as Chair of the Committee, and he was elected. Kevin Skattum nominated Judy Shuster for the position of Vice-Chair, and she was elected to that position.

STAFF REPORTS

"Flight" dedication update. The dedication is set for Friday, May 13, at 4 p.m. The sculpture is already installed. The artist will be at the dedication, and PRAC has been invited to attend. Dave McMahon has volunteered to comment at the event.

Yellow Pod/Championship Field update. The installation of artificial turf on the Yellow Pod is complete. The surrounding landscaping will be completed soon. The area is large enough for six full-sized soccer fields. Mike Schrad suggested adding signage prohibiting pets and food from the field.

Work has started on replacing the artificial turf on the Championship Field with higher-quality material.

Dog Park. Plans for redesign of the dog park and making it a permanent site are moving forward, including the additional parking.

OLD BUSINESS

PROJECTS, CONCEPT REVIEWS, PLANNED DEVELOPMENTS

Summit Green Apartments. This project is located near the Wal-Mart store in Flatiron Crossing. Discussion is ongoing with the developer to move the dedicated public land from the center of the development, as it is currently proposed, to make it more accessible to the public.

Cityscapes. Cityscapes is located on Highway 128, near the Detention Center. Staff has asked the developer to coordinate with the developer of The Ridge, which is adjacent, in order to provide a larger, combined park area.

Broomfield Business Center. This apartment complex is located near 96th Street, Northwest Parkway, and Via Varra. Del Corso Park is located there. Staff has asked a new developer at the site to work to combine dedicated land with the existing Del Corso Park so that the area is larger. A dog park has been included in staff requests.

Crossings Church of the Nazarene. This project is in the very early stages. It is located near Huron Street and the Northwest Parkway. It includes senior living, mixed uses, and multi-family units. Early submittals from the owner did not include public land dedication.

Anthem Community Park. Included in this park proposal near Siena Reservoir were a full-size baseball field, a softball field, two rectangular fields, among other amenities. The Farmers Reservoir and Irrigation Company (FRICO) has a vehicular crossing to their ditch. FRICO must provide access permission before the project can move forward.
