AGENDA AND MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by Gary Sherrer. The agenda was approved by consensus. Carolyn Romero made a motion to approve the minutes. KC Lancaster seconded. The vote was unanimous.

REPORTS

STAFF REPORTS AND UPDATES

- John King Sculpture for HHS East Entryway is being installed on Saturday between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- Open Space and Trails is conducting an open house regarding McKay/Lambertson on June 22 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Lakeshore room in the BCC. Updated drawings should be on the website now. Kathryn Bergh is discussing criteria for public art with Xcel Energy.
- Next Walk in the Art is June 15 at 6 p.m. right before the first summer concert. We will meet in front of the library.
- Staff was called by *Sculpture Magazine*. They are covering a story on art on loan programs from around the country and the writer was impressed with our program. He was very interested in getting the artists' perspective especially when their art has been purchased so staff provided contact information for Scy Caroselli and Maureen Hearty.
- AFA call for sculptures went live on June 6.
- Over 70 people have already voted in Broomfield's Choice.
- Katy Olmsted and KC Lancaster participated in Trails Day on June 4. KC Lancaster and Roxanne Macke created the Broomfield Public Art Coloring Books. They were a hit. Over fifty people stopped by to ask questions.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Select the Finalist for the HHS 3rd Floor Call

Debbie Oldenettel reminded the committee that the 3rd floor Family Services area needs to provide a calming and relaxing environment. The space will be used for all ages including teens. The Workforce Center may use the space for teen programming.

The PAC received 82 responses for the Request for Proposals and after three rounds of jurying narrowed the candidates to seven. After reviewing and deliberating over the seven finalist candidates, the Public Art Committee along with the HHS staff selected the artist Annette Coleman. Kalia Garrido made a motion to work with Annette Colman to create the final design for the HHS 3rd floor project. KC Lancaster seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Annette Coleman’s proposal is to create a mosaic using colored tiles. The design of the mosaic is a collaborative process and the artist will submit an initial sketch which will be reviewed by members of the PAC and city staff. Working together the team will determine the final design and colors staying mindful of the desire to keep the space calming and relaxing.

Review Community Mural Survey Results

PAC reviewed the results of an internal survey. The Broomfield Community Center exterior was designated as the top preference for location. \$30k-\$40k is the preference for budget range. Artist should lead the project. The PAC agreed to limit community involvement for this first mural project.

Next Steps for Community Mural Project

Staff will consult with the Director of Recreation and Director of Facilities to see if there are any issues with proceeding with the Broomfield Community Center location. KC Lancaster offered to gather the input to determine the concept ideas or themes for the new project.

NEW BUSINESS

Plan Public Art Field Trip

Field trip is tabled for the time being. PAC will look for potential locations for *Music Inside*.

Carolyn Romero is interested in bike rack locations and placement throughout the city. Sharon Tessier suggested skateboard parking as well.

Carolyn Romero asked for a budget update for the next meeting and the map of all sculpture locations.
