The meeting was called to order by Sherill Bunetta, Committee Chair, at 6:36 pm at the Brunner Farmhouse. The minutes from the 2 May 2016 meeting and the agenda for tonight's meeting were approved as submitted.

OLD BUSINESS

WINDMILL – Kevin Standbridge's office has been very busy, consequently they have not had an opportunity to do anything on this project.

MONTHLY BUSINESS

1. HOUSE REQUESTS: The Savory Pond request to use the Farmhouse on 14 July 2016 was processed via e-mail with the committee earlier in June. It was the only new request. It was approved via e-mail.
2. SPRING CLEAN-UP: The 14 May event was well attended by 21 people representing 12 groups that use the Farmhouse.
3. GROUNDS AND GARDENS: The consensus was that we have lots of color in the gardens this year. It was also noted that the weeds are growing as well. Iris' across the various garden beds need to be cut back and volunteers need to step up and do weed removal and deadheading of the roses on a weekly basis.
 - a. We need volunteers for the BLUE and PURPLE Gardens. Teri Floyd suggested we get the Enterprise Newspaper involved in seeking more publicity for this need.
 - b. Mark Brunner said he will have his Landscaping crew prune the bushes.
 - c. Mark recommended that gardeners provide more separation between plants in the various color gardens. Many plants are overgrown.
 - d. The consensus was that we owe R. Juul a big THANK YOU for all her extra work in several of the garden beds. She has volunteered a lot of extra time and labor to improve the gardens.
 - e. It was noted that the Public is welcome to pick apples from the trees in front of the Farmhouse. Apparently leftover fruit on the ground attracts Coyotes.

- b. Item 59 Parking Lot – Per Kevin, City Engineers are considering a plan to remove the current crusher fine covering, put a layer of fabric down, and then relaying the crusher fine. Still pending; more information to follow.

 - d. Item 61 Art Hanging System – per Kevin, still pending.

NEW BUSINESS


- 1. Sherill reported that Vivian gave presentations inside the Farmhouse to two elementary school groups.
