AGENDA AND MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by Gary Sherrer. The agenda was approved by consensus. KC Lancaster made a motion to approve the minutes with revisions. Bill McCann seconded. The vote was unanimous.

REPORTS

ART BENCHES & SCULPTURES

- *River Otter* looks great
- *Global Supremacy* is rusting. However, the artist intended for the metal to rust and it's holding up well for a five year old sculpture.
- *Illuminate!* is having lighting issues again. Staff will contact the artist.
- Artist Joe McGrane will be making the repairs needed at *Solar System: Myths and Matter*.
- John King installed the last component of *Balance in Motion* on August 5.

STAFF REPORTS AND UPDATES

- **Broomfield Community Center (BCC) 2D Exterior Wall Installation Project Update:** The presentation to City Council has been moved out for 45 days. City Council is in the process of deciding the future of BCC.
- **McKay / Lambertson Update:**
 - ✓ Kathryn Bergh, CIP Project Manager, stated they are still in the queue to meet with Xcel's Engineering and ROW.
 - ✓ Kathryn will present at City Council on September 13 with a pre-project review. Staff is requesting a City Council Resolution to apply for Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) funds.
 - ✓ A separate package will be bid for winter/spring construction of the parking lot, Zuni sidewalk and pedestrian crossing improvements. The construction plans for the rest of the site should be substantially complete next month.
 - ✓ The GOCO grant will be awarded in April. The outcome of the award will set the schedule for the rest of the project. In the meantime, we will be importing dirt and stockpiling "found" construction materials such as boulders and logs.
- **Broomfield Days, September 17:** PAC will promote Broomfield's Choice and Public Art Coloring Books. Staff will have coloring books and PAC stickers printed. KC Lancaster volunteered to work from 11:30 a.m. - 1 p.m. Katy Olmsted volunteered to work from 1-3 p.m. Gary Sherrer volunteered for the morning shift.
- **Broomfield's Choice Update:** 156 people have participated.

- o **Citizen Request for crusher fine trail at Flight:** A citizen requested a crusher fine trail at Flight. Kristan Printz, Director of Open Space, and the charmain of Open Space and Trails Committee (OSTAC) are willing to look into creating a permanent trail. Staff will meet at the site next week to discuss the possibilities.
- o **Update on 3rd Floor HHS Project:** Annette Coleman’s contract is being routed through the City Manager’s Office.
- o **Balance in Motion Dedication:** A subcommittee comprised of Gary Sherrer and Carolyn Romero will develop ideas for the dedication of John King’s sculptures. Staff will connect them to Debbie Oldenettel, Director of Health and Human Services, to coordinate the dedication plans.

PUBLIC COMMENT

A.J. Davis and Jackson Ellis are local artist/sculptors/muralists interested in seeing how the public art process works. Tiimo Mang is a sculptor that submitted to the Art for Awhile call.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Location for Music Inside

PAC did a straw poll to see where members wanted to place the sculpture. The three options are 1) Midway Park by the Girl Scout Shelter 2) Arista 3) Wildgrass. The poll majority was for Midway Park. Staff will work with Parks for the placement.

Review 2016 Art for Awhile Sculpture

PAC will review the 2016 sculptures to determine which sculptures they are interested in and where they should be placed. PAC will send photos to staff of potential locations.
