- Concussion training (10-12's Division and older)

**All volunteer packet information must be completed before any volunteer coaches (including assistants) can begin practice.**

### **Concussion Training**

#### **Must be completed before you can get your roster**

Jake Snakenberg Youth Concussion Act requires anyone coaching youth 11-18 years old in an organized sport to complete concussion training. This can be accomplished online. **This is a yearly requirement that is a mandate from the State of Colorado.** Coaches can complete the on-line training at
