**Case Report #:** 14-1385

On Saturday, March 15, 2014 at approximately 2:45 a.m., a passerby observed a white Toyota Camry that had driven into the side of the Peerless Tire building located at 11985 Teller Street. A male was seen exiting the car and walking away from the scene of the accident. Officers searched the area and the driver of the vehicle was not found. Several thousand dollars in damage to the business were incurred.

At approximately, 5:55 p.m., Kavon Andrew Nikmanesh (DOB 10/23/1984) came into the Police Department and stated that he was the driver of the car that ran into the side of the Peerless Tire building earlier in the morning. Nikmanesh stated that he lost control of the car when he was driving and it ran into the side of the Peerless Tire building. Nikmanesh is not the registered owner of the Toyota Camry however the car belongs to his father. Nikmanesh was arrested for the following charges:

- Hit and Run
- Reckless Driving
- Duty upon striking an unattended vehicle or property

Nikmanesh was released on a \$500 bond at approximately 9:00 p.m. with a scheduled court date of April 22, 2014.
