

Don't miss Summer Sundays at the Brunner House

The annual Summer Sundays at the Brunner House are back this year with the first of three events beginning on June 8, 2014. The afternoon starts with a carnival for kids at 4 p.m., followed by a musical concert from 6 to 8 p.m.

The historic, 100-year-old farmhouse on the hill at 640 Main Street is the perfect place for concerts on its wrap around porch, enjoyable setting and the carnival on the lawn. The activities are reminiscent of the casual summer activities of yesteryear, with a modern twist.

June 8, 2014, the kid's carnival includes games, prizes, inflatable, face painting, storytelling, art and food. After the carnival, bring a lawn chair and enjoy an evening concert from the back porch. The concert features the popular bluegrass band "Southern Exposure". July 13, 2014, the monthly event continues with a special feature concert favorite. The dynamic duo of Skanson and Hansen performs exciting, intricate and beautiful guitar duets of music of popular 60's and 70's, classical and original compositions. They also draw from celtic, Spanish, gospel, reggae, calypso, rock & roll just to name a few. The Kid's Carnival starts at 4 p.m. with the entertainment starting at 6 p.m.

August 10, 2014, the annual event closes with a kid's carnival beginning at 4 p.m. followed by the ever popular and requested Metropolitan Jazz Orchestra at 6 to 8:00 p.m. This 18 piece band features Denver's finest jazz musicians that play big band selections ranging from the 40's through the 90's that has entertained Broomfield audiences for several years.
