DR. COLORADO AND JACQUI AINLAY-CONLEY PRESENT RAILROAD STORIES: TRACKS ACROSS COLORADO AND BROOMFIELD

The historic speaker series presented by the Broomfield Depot Museum & Friends and the Crescent Grange continues on Wednesday, September 3, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with "Railroad Stories: Tracks across Colorado and Broomfield."

Noted historian Dr. Tom Noel and City and County of Broomfield Museum Administrator Jacqui Ainlay-Conley will talk about railroad history along the Front Range and share stories about trains that ran through Broomfield.

Dr. Tom Noel, also known as "Dr. Colorado," is a professor of history at the University of Colorado Denver and Co-Director of the Center for Colorado & the West at Auraria. He is the author of numerous articles, columns, and books including "Colorado: A Liquid History & Tavern Guide to the Highest State." He also appears on Channel 9's popular program "Colorado & Co." Noel and Ainlay-Conley are co-editors of the Colorado Book Review.

The talk is free, however, seating is limited.
